Anne H. DeBerry Brzezinski, 89, died February 17, 2009, in Nashville. Born in Robertson County, she moved to Washington, D.C. as a young woman, where she met her husband Sigismund (Ziggy) and raised her daughter Evelyn, now of Portland, OR. She was employed by the Navy Department from 1941 to 1972, at which time she and her husband retired and returned to Robertson County.
