Armand J. St. Pierre, age 91 of Springfield and formerly of Bath, NY, passed away Monday, March 7, 2016 at his home.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at Our Lady of Lourdes in Springfield at 10am Thursday, March 10, 2016.

A Memorial Service will be held at St. Mary's in Bath, NY later this year.
