Berry Jackson "Major" Duncan, Jr., age 92, of Springfield, passed away Tuesday, December 29, 2009 at NorthCrest Medical Center. A memorial service will be held Tuesday, January 5, 2009 at the United Methodist Church in Greenbrier at 10:00am.
