Billy Ray Jackson, age 80, of Cedar Hill, passed away Tuesday, January 27, 2026, at Skyline Medical Center. Funeral services will be conducted on Tuesday, February 3rd at 1pm in the chapel of the Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Springfield with Bro. Ronnie Green, officiating. 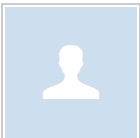
