March 30, 1945 - September 17, 2020

Bobby Murphey Coutts, age 75 of Whites Creek, Tennessee, died Thursday, September 17, 2020 at his home.

He was born on March 30, 1945 in Springfield, Tennessee to the late Joe Clinton and Julia Bell Murphey Coutts, Jr. Bobby was born again June 17, 1956 and dedicated his life to the Lords work. He served as a missionary with the International Mission Board, SBC as an evangelist and church planter in Benin, West Africa for 35 years. He was a member of Parkway Baptist Church and Springfield Baptist Church was his home Church.

In addition to his parents he is preceded in death by an infant brother, Joe Clinton Coutts, III.

Bobby is survived by his wife, Rebekah "Becky" Jan Haltom Coutts of Whites Creek; sons, Joshua John Coutts and Rocco Daniel Dominic Coutts; brothers, Gary Edward (Dottie) Coutts and William "Bill" Porter (Sandra) Coutts; sisters, Marilyn (Ken) Lee, Carolyn (Larry) Mitchell, and Joanne (Terry) Eden.
