



Burns "Speedy" Bibee

July 11, 1941 - August 31, 2013

Silas Burns "Speedy" Bibee, age 72, of Springfield, passed away Saturday, August 31, 2013 at Vanderbilt Medical Center. Celebration of Life services will be held Friday, September 6, 2013 at 1pm in the chapel of the Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Springfield with Brother Ted Ingram officiating. Burial will follow in the Robertson County Memorial Gardens with Zachary Allen, Jacob Allen, Nate Allen, Woody Wilson, John Alan Bishop and Charles Bibee serving as pallbearers.
