Charles Edwin Strange, MD, age 76 of Adams, passed away Tuesday, April 24, 2012 at his home. Funeral services will be held Saturday, April 28, 2012 at 11am in the chapel of the Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Springfield with Brother John Casey officiating.
