Daniella Enriquez, age 24 of Lyles, Tennessee died July 6th, 2019 after a long and courageous battle with brain cancer. Survived by her parents, Servando and Ana G. Figueroa Lara Enriquez, brothers, Douglas Figueroa, Walter G. Ramirez, and Allan C. Figueroa; half brother, Ludwin Enriquez; half sisters, Alma, Carla and Leslie Enriquez; numerous aunts, uncles, cousins and friends and her beloved dog, Cosmo.

Funeral Services will be held at Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Pleasant View, TN on Sunday, July 14th at 2 o'clock pm with Rev. Monna Mayhall presiding. The family will receive friends from 12 noon until the hour of service at 2:00PM.

Daniella graduated from Hickman County High School in 2013, attended UT Chattanooga and was to have graduated from Columbia State in May of this year. She always dreamed of having 2 jobs – a translator and a teacher. As a child in kindergarten, Daniella translated for other children. Her first grade teacher said she wished she had "a room full of Daniellas".

In high school, Daniella was a cheerleader, was involved in theater and

travelled to London to represent Hickman County in a parade. Her senior year, she was voted “Best Dressed” and Homecoming Queen. Daniella loved to travel and took multiple trips to Guatemala to distribute clothing to the poor. She loved dressing up – especially at Halloween, was an avid Harry Potter fan, listened to the “oldies” music station and LOVED Frank Sinatra. She loved animals so much that she refused to eat fish because she had a pond filled with Koi.

Last year, Daniella was granted a trip to California, courtesy of The Dream Foundation where she spent 3 weeks with her family. She was the speaker and honoree at the Dreamland Gala on November 5, 2018 in Santa Barbara, CA. The event raised over one million dollars that night.

Daniella’s family would like to thank everyone for the love and support during her illness, especially Beverly Headley, Ellen Kirk, Nancy Black, Becky Farmer, Alive Hospice and St. Paul’s Episcopal Church in Franklin.

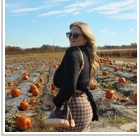

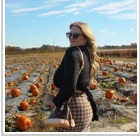
