



## Dr. Huba Nagy

August 5, 1939 - July 16, 2024

Huba Nagy, aged 84, passed away on July 16, 2024, in Brentwood, TN. Born on August 5, 1939, in Budapest, Hungary, Huba lived a life marked by resilience, joy, and service. He escaped Hungary during the 1956 Hungarian Revolution and subsequently lived in the United Kingdom and Canada before settling in Tennessee in 1978. He moved to Franklin in 1984, where he spent the remainder of his life.

A graduate of Memorial University of Newfoundland, Canada, Huba dedicated his career to medicine, helping countless people as a physician. Despite facing personal challenges with a disability, he never let it define him or dampen his spirit. Huba was known for his fun-loving nature, often seen smiling and laughing, and he had a profound sense of adventure and duty.

Huba married Lois Clarke in 1972, and the couple raised two sons, Timothy and Philip. Huba is survived by his wife, sons, sister Sophie, brother Jenci, and grandchildren Peter, Matthew, and Anna. He was preceded in death by his parents, Jenő and Ida Nagy. He was an active member of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Franklin, TN, where he also volunteered his time generously.

Beyond his professional and spiritual commitments, Huba was deeply involved in his community. He was an active member of the Rotary and

volunteered many years at the Franklin Rodeo, demonstrating his commitment to service and community engagement.
