William Edward “Ed” Reed, age 87, of Springfield, passed away Saturday, November 16, 2019 at NorthCrest Medical Center. Funeral Services will be held Thursday, November 21, 2019 at 11am in the chapel of the Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Springfield with Brother Clay Burchett officiating. 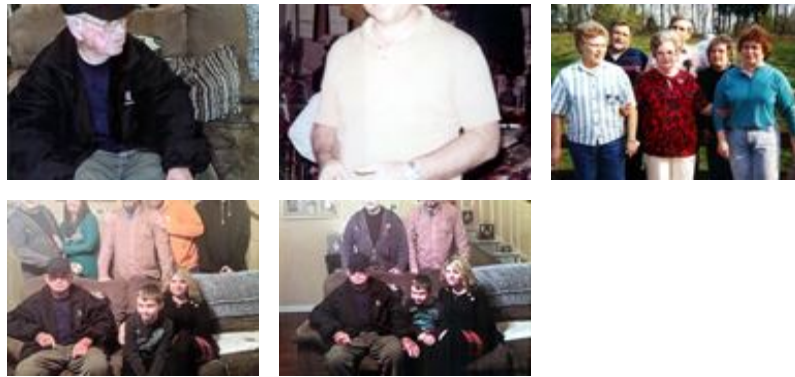
