Edward Miller Williams, Sr., age 85, of Jacksonville, Florida, passed away peacefully Saturday, June 5, 2010 at the McGraw Center for Caring with Community Hospice care. Funeral services will be held Wednesday, June 9, 2010 at 11am in the chapel of the Austin & Bell Funeral Home with Brother Joe Hinkle officiating. Entombment will follow in the Mausoleum of the Robertson County Memorial Gardens with family and friends serving as pallbearers. Visitation will be held at the funeral home Wednesday morning from 10am until the time of service.

Mr. Williams was born April 27, 1925 in Jacksonville, FL to the late Elmer and Minnie Belle Williams. He graduated from Robert E. Lee High School and from the University of Florida in 1950. He was a veteran, serving in the Army Airforce as a Flight Officer and Navigator.
