Elgia Harris Alley, Jr., age 85, of Greenbrier, went to be with the Lord on Monday, June 22, 2015. He was surrounded by his beloved wife of almost 65 years, Martha B. Alley, and family.

Funeral services will be held Thursday, June 25, 2015 at 1:30pm in the chapel of the Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Greenbrier with Brother Jon Briggs officiating. Burial will follow in the Forest Lawn Cemetery with Colt Alley, David Brehm, Kenny McDonald, Stephen Williams and Cade McDonald, Keeton Bunn, James T.
