



## Emory Henley

January 15, 1940 - February 8, 2020

Emory Lee Henley, age 80 of Clarksville, Tennessee, died Saturday, February 8, 2020 at his home.

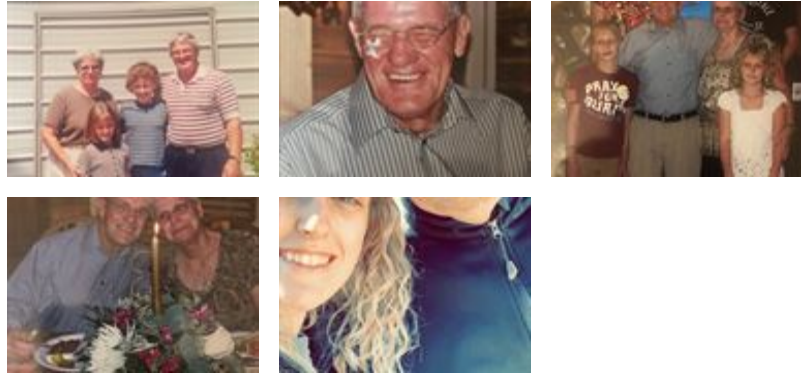
