Faye Hall, age 79 died Saturday, February 8, 2020. She was born in Springfield, Tennessee to J.C. and Cecil Morris on November 4, 1940. Known to everyone as "Granny Hall", her family was her life. A member of Center Point Church, Granny Hall loved to cook and cooked everything from scratch. Her children say it was impossible for Faye to cook for only 2 people. The most beloved dishes were her chicken and dumplings, fried chicken, goulash, banana pudding and her world famous fried apple pies. (Sorry but there are no written recipes so no need to ask) Her homemade biscuits will never be duplicated. She attempted to teach everyone in the family how to make them but it can't be done. At Christmas when the family was together, she loved watching everyone say the lines to Christmas Vacation while watching the movie.
