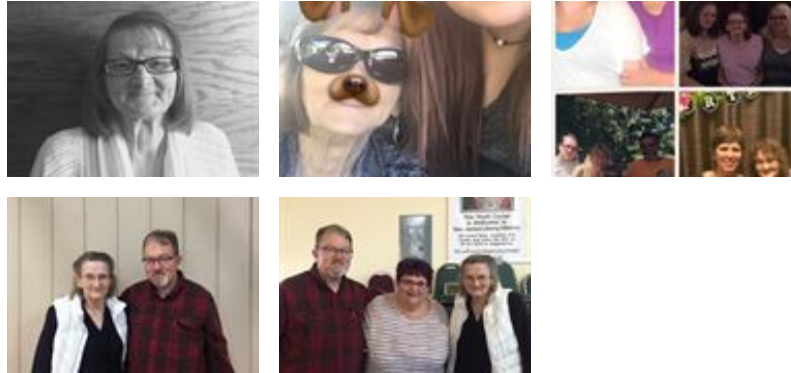
My pleasure! Remembering her keeps bringing this verse to my mind from an old hymn we used to sing called "Keep On The Firing Line"
