



## Frank O'Brien Fisher

October 10, 1933 - March 11, 2016

Age 82. Passed away March 11, 2016. Mr. Fisher was born October 10, 1933 in Kyles Ford, TN to Rufus Lloyd and Verna America Fisher. He is preceded in death by his parents; Survived by 3 sons, Kevin Fisher, Xenia, OH, Rufus (Tanya) Fisher, Greenbrier TN and Dwayne (Jeanette) Fisher, Portland, TN; brother, Jack (Becky) Fisher.; 6 grandchildren, Sara Fisher, Jordi Fisher, Zach Jines, Joelle Jines, Luke fisher and Jayden Fisher. Mr. Fisher served as a USMC veteran Southeast Asia theater, and Brien was awarded the National Defense Service medal, Korea Service medal, United Nations Medal, China Service Medal, received Sharpshooter Sniper status and was honorably discharged.

In a very different capacity, he went on to become a Grammy and CMA award-winning record producer with Gold and Platinum albums, three #1 chart records, and 27 top 10 chart records.

He was a beloved father, and dear friend at the time of his passing on March 11, 2016.

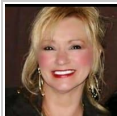

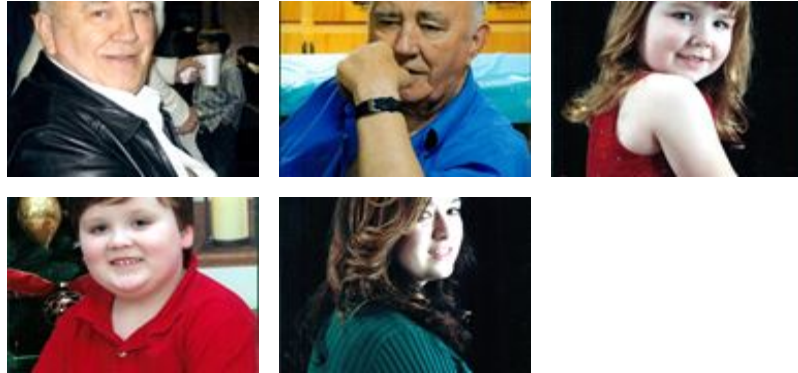
