Fred Thomas Morris, age 92, of Clarksville, Tennessee, died Sunday, April 28, 2024 at his home.

Funeral services will be conducted at Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Pleasant View at 11:00AM on Thursday, May 2nd, with Bro. Gene Parton officiating. Burial will follow in Mallory's Cemetery with family serving as pallbearers.

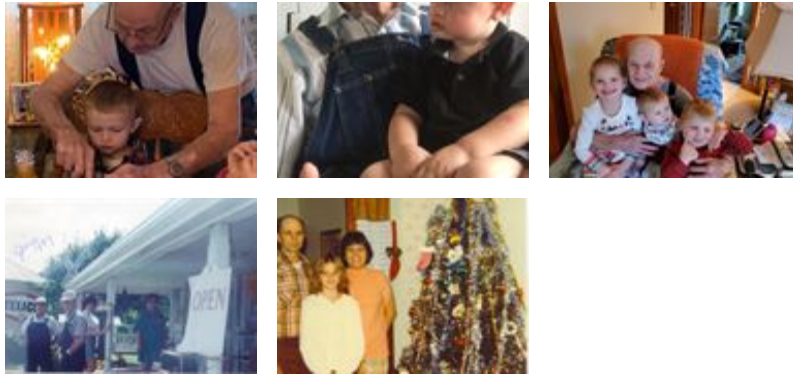
