



## Harry Hargrave Hudson,

August 28, 1919 - June 4, 2013

Harry Hargrave Hudson, Sr., age 93, of Springfield, passed away Tuesday, June 04, 2013 at NHC Healthcare. Funeral services will be held Thursday, June 6, 2013 at 11am in the chapel of the Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Springfield with Brother Joe Rushing officiating. Burial will follow in the Spring Hill Cemetery in Madison, TN with Seth Hudson, Will Hudson, Kipp Cherry, Perry Mason, Jim Wilhite and Joe Jackson serving as pallbearers. Mr. Hudson was also a devoted member of the Springfield Lions Club for 45 years and was an active member of the community serving on numerous "boards" for the City of Springfield.

In addition to his parents Mr. Hudson is preceded in death by his wife, Grace Bailey Hudson. He is survived by his son, Harry "Buddy" Hudson, Jr. of

Hendersonville, NC; daughter, Patricia “Trish” Hudson of Springfield; grandchildren, Seth Hudson, Will Hudson, Kipp Cherry and Nicole Hernandez; and great-grandchildren, Kayla, Brittany, Anna Grace, Matt and Morgan.
