Gordon “Jackie” Lee Hunter, age 70 of Ashland City, Tennessee, passed away surrounded by loved ones on Wednesday, February 3, 2021 at his home.

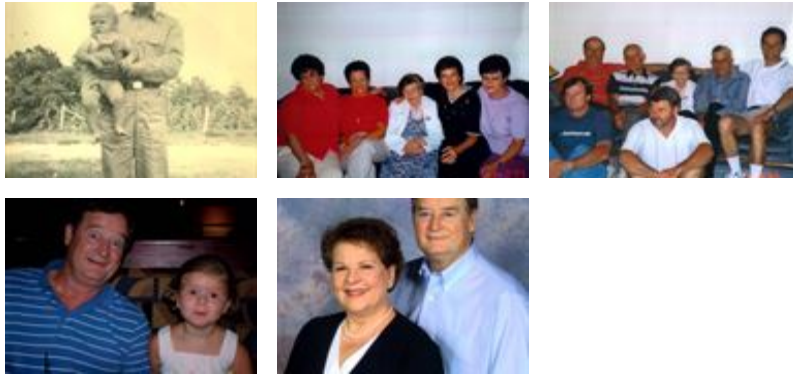
