Jackie (Jack) Lee Jones, aged 78, passed away at his home in Springfield, TN, on Mon., July 27. Jack was born in Wingo, KY and spent the majority of his earlier years living and attending school in Mayfield, KY. After graduating from high school Jack worked a year for the FBI in Washington, D.C. and upon returning to Western Kentucky he attended and graduated from Murray State University. While attending Murray State Jack was a charter member of Sigma Chi fraternity.

Jack spent the majority of his working career as a sales rep for Belknap Hardware in Winter Haven, FL. and later in Springfield, TN. While working for Belknap he was named "Salesman of the Year" several times.

Jack is survived by his daughter Shannon Lee Jones and her husband David DeBeck of Boston, MA, a grandson, Mitchell Lee Bland of Knoxville, TN, a brother, Larry T. Jones of Mayfield, KY and his first wife and mother of his children, Nancy Sykes Cockerham of Winter Haven, FL.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Teenie Anderson Jones, his daughter Deanna Gail Bland and his parents, H. L. and Madeline Walker Jones.
