When we found that beaver dam and wandered in the fields. You made me feel brave. Like you were brave. I miss those moments. They seem like fever dreams now. I miss you. And I haven’t let myself all these years. Because I haven’t deserved to. I didn’t love you as I should on this side of heaven, so why would I have the right to grieve you like this. You missed all the important moments in my life. You’ve missed my future ones too. I dread knowing you won’t know my kids, you won’t see me get married, and I won’t be able to have you around in my older years. Brett has two kids now. And he got married to a wonderful woman - Nat’e. She wouldn’t have put up with your crap, and you would have loved her for it. And Justin and Angelia had Kate. You would love them. They all have your stubbornness.

It pains me. I want you here. I want the chance to be a better sister. I want the chance to know you and to support you. I’m so upset that I ever took you to Nashville that night. I wish I would have asked you to watch a movie with me instead. But I didn’t. I was young and selfish and stupid. But I loved you. Even though you treated me like I was forever 12 years old. You were special to me. And I loved the scar on your forehead, because I imagined that was what Harry

Potters looked like. I loved your voice because I imagined that's what Harris's voice sounded like. I loved your laugh and the way you made me spicy rice. I loved how you made those dumb detox drinks and peed SO loudly in the bathroom above my room. LOL it annoyed me when I was younger but it makes me laugh now. You were the best brother to me when I was little. And you meant so much to me even though I didn't show it. I'm sorry I didn't show it. You weren't a disappointment - you were my hero for the longest time. I just didn't know what to do when my hero has struggled I couldn't comprehend. I didn't love how you treated dad. I didn't love how you talked to Brett. But I loved you Jerry. I was too young to understand. And I still don't understand everything. But I loved you. And I still really love you Jerry. There's not a day that goes by that I don't think about you. I'll see you in heaven again. I know I will. But until then, know that I love you. Your memory is never forgotten, (no matter how hard I try). Until Heaven.

Even so, God has a glorious plan, even when we are taken to His promised land.

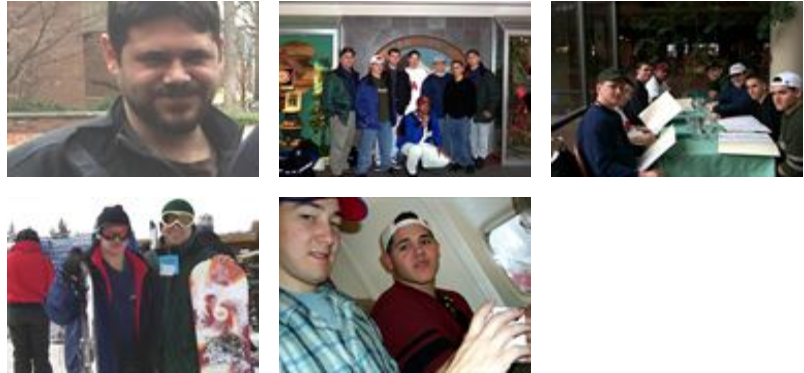
Trust in Him & let your faith keep you strong because "God is good all the time," even when we loose a loved one.
