Jason Wayne Hudgens, age 50, of Pleasant View, Tennessee, died Tuesday, December 17, 2024, at TriStar Skyline Medical Center in Nashville.

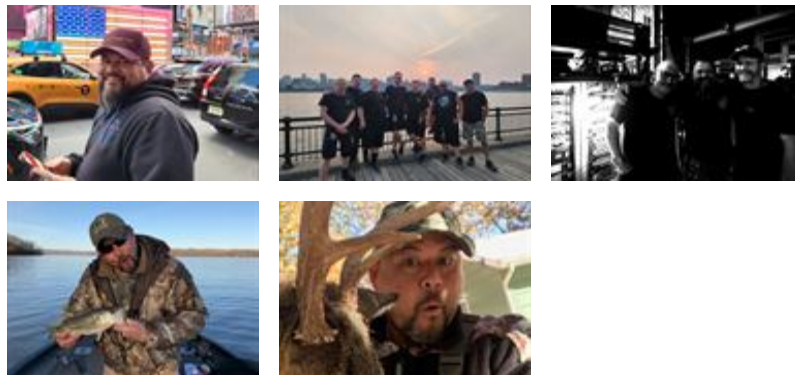
