



## Jeffrey Alan Williams

Jeffrey Alan Williams, 60, died Saturday, January 16, 2016 at his home. Austin & Bell Funeral Home Greenbrier is in charge of arrangements.

He was born June 26, 1955 in Robertson County to the late Harris and Peggy Williams. Jeffrey was known for his quick wit and humor as well as his interest in firearms and aircraft.

He was a private pilot, a certified small arms instructor, and a proud member of the NRA. He devoted most of his life to serving his country as a Naval Aviation Ordinance man in the U.S. Navy. During that time he was assigned to several different aircraft carriers including the USS Nimitz. He won many awards at Camp Perry while on the United States Navy Rifle team. He retired from the Navy after 20 years of service. He then spent 15 years working for Dupont before retiring again. He is survived by 3 siblings; Lynette (Dennis) McNeal, Dennis (Bee) Williams and Cheryl Williams; nephews, Ben Williams and Daniel (Victoria) Williams; niece, Amanda (Chris) Smith and great-nieces, Evy and Nora Smith. He will be greatly missed.
