Jon Wayne Crutcher, age 80, of Coopertown, died Saturday, February 07, 2015, at St. Thomas West in Nashville. Funeral services will be conducted 1 o'clock pm Wednesday, February 11th, at the Battle Creek Baptist Church with Rev. David Apple officiating.
