“ Dear Dennis, family and friends of dear Karen,

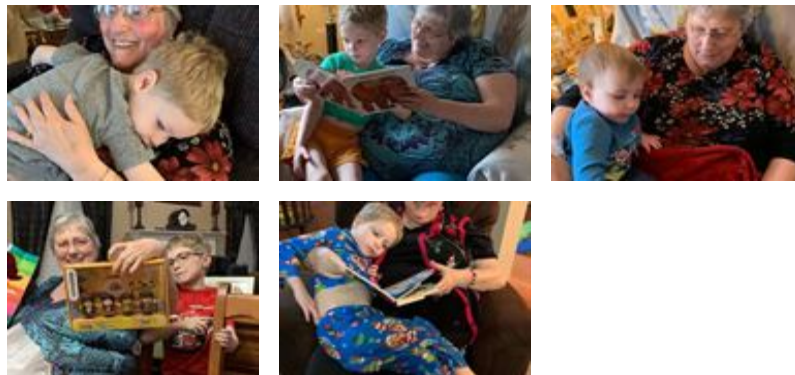
