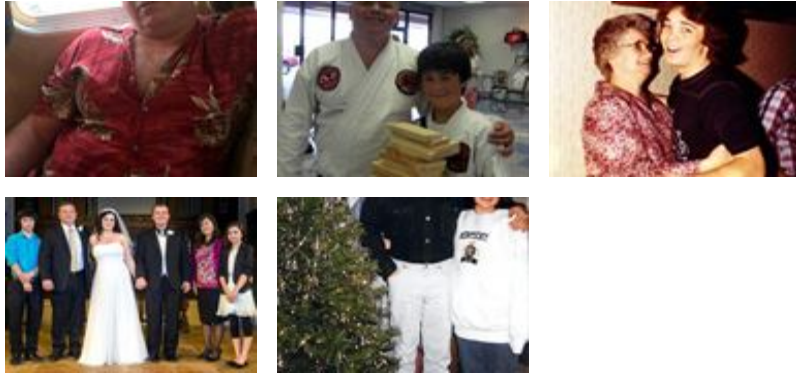

When I would hear our "role call" in the mornings I would dread being on The tougher units, that is unless I heard Kevin's name being called out beside my own. He always helped lend a hand when I was in over my head and made sure I would get my lunch breaks always taking over my patient load and asking me to go first to eat before himself. That's Kevin, always putting others before himself including his patients and co-workers. He would be so lighthearted at work, always cracking a joke to make us laugh even when he was working on his 3rd or 4th shift that week and never complained one bit but was always talking about his sweet wife Anna is and how hard she worked, "working opposite schedules as me to help pay for our kids college and still doing loads of laundry when she got off!" I was amazed daily on how in love with you he was and I longed to have a husband that talked about me the way he did about you!
