Captain (Ret.) Larry Sylvester Green, age 78, of Cedar Hill, TN, died Thursday, June 18, 2015 at White Haven Assisted Living in Adams. Cpt Green was my brothers Company Commander in 1966 in Vietnam. I was recently researching the service of my brother (who died there) and discovered how great a leader Cpt Green was and how highly was respected by his men, and how he respected my brother. This is all present in the words of Captain Green, himself:

LCpl Jerry Patrick was my Radio Operator when I commanded Co "M" 3d Bn 3d Marines. He was a former grenadier who, it was said, could put a "blooper" round in a VC's back pocket at 200 meters. He was an outstanding Marine who was loved by the entire company. He had only five days left in northern I Corps and he begged me to allow him to go with the Company on a mission to the west of a promontory known as "The Razorback." I relented and let him go with us, and have regretted it ever since. He was killed by an errant bomb from a "friendly" A-4.

There was no Marine who personified Semper Fidelis better than Jerry Patrick. The Corps and the Country lost a dedicated young man. My prayers are with his family."
