Lloyd George Plunkett, age 85 of Pleasant View, Tennessee, died Wednesday, January 19, 2022 at Walking Horse Meadows in Clarksville.

Funeral services will be conducted at Bethel Free Will Baptist Church in Ashland City at 3:00PM on Sunday, January 23rd, with Bro. Barry Raper officiating. Burial will follow in Bethel Cemetery with family and friends serving as pallbearers.
