Lynda Dunn Teasley, age 87, of the Sandy Springs/Gause Community, passed away Friday, September 21, 2018 at her home from Alzheimer's Disease.

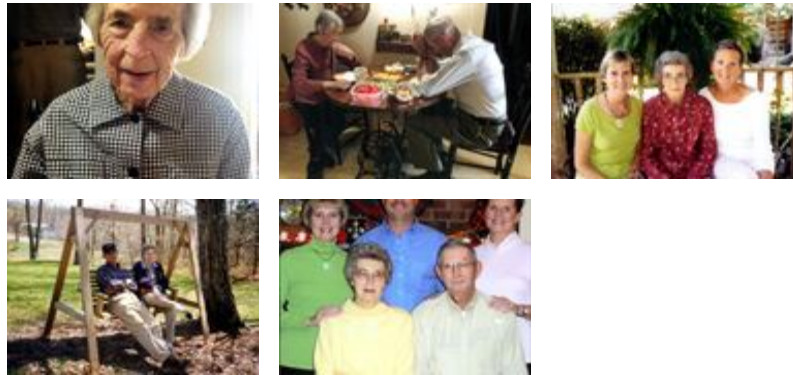
