Mack Doss Cook, age 85, of Greenbrier, passed away peacefully Wednesday, March 25, 2015 at Brighton Gardens in Brentwood, Tennessee. A Memorial service will be held Sunday, March 29, 2015 at 2:00 PM in the chapel of the Austin & Bell Funeral home in Springfield, Tennessee with Brother Bob Cook officiating.
