Nona Fay Randolph, age 101, born December 2, 1911, passed away on July 20, 2014 in Nashville. Nona was born and raised in Springfield, TN, but had been a resident of Nashville since 1978. She will be missed by her family and by all of those who knew her, but she lived a full life and left Nashville a better place.

Nona was preceded in death by her parents, Bayless and Effie Randolph, brother, James and her sister, Dorothy. She leaves two loving nephews, James Randolph, Jr. of Dallas, TX and James Gower of San Mateo, CA and their families including grand-nephew, Matt Gower of San Mateo, CA and three great-nieces, Melissa Huber of La Habra, CA, Lindsey Randolph of New York, NY and Laura Randolph of Santa Monica, CA.

Nona earned an undergraduate degree in education and a Master's Degree from Peabody College and Vanderbilt in Nashville.

Following a six year assignment in Washington, DC working in the War Department, Nona embarked on a 38 year teaching career in the public school systems, primarily in Dallas, TX. Following her teaching career, Nona moved back to Nashville where she travelled extensively and pursued her interest in volunteer work throughout the city. She was a founder of Delta Kappa Gamma and Woman's Club of Nashville. She was a long time member of Immanuel Baptist Church.

Nona's health and mobility required her to move into the Blakeford at Green Hills in 2007, where she made a number of great friends whom she enjoyed

and experienced loving care from the staff.
