



Owen Morton Shearer

Owen Morton (Mort) Shearer, 83, of Springfield, TN, passed away as peacefully as possible after a very short battle with pneumonia, with his family by his side in the early morning hours of November 20, 2021 at NorthCrest Medical Center.

A memorial service will be held Tuesday, December 7, 2021 at 6pm in the chapel of the Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Springfield with Brother Ronnie Carter officiating.

Mr. Shearer was born September 08, 1938 in Covington, KY to the late Bro. William Morton and Anne Holland Fagan Shearer. He was retired owner/operator of Mort's "World Famous" Market in Springfield and previous owner of 49 Market, also in Springfield. Mort was a member of Coopertown Church of Christ.

Mort graduated from Coopertown High School in 1959. He attended college at UT Memphis and graduated with a double major in Chemistry and Biology. After college, he joined the United State Marine Corp and become a helicopter pilot in 1963, later joining the Vietnam War.

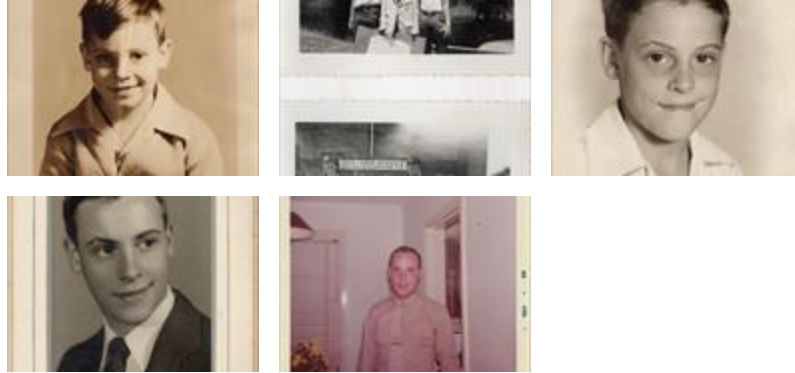
