

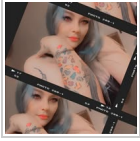


Patricia Elaine Capps

August 6, 1965 - April 8, 2013

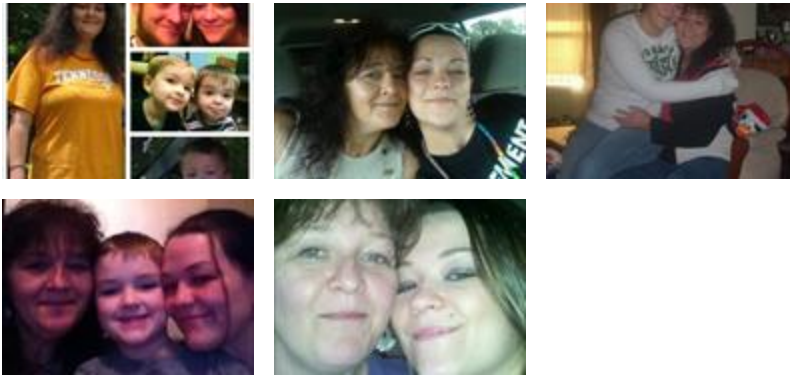
