The Rev. Phillip Barry Wright, age 72 of Hendersonville, Tennessee, passed away Tuesday, May 24, 2022, at his home surrounded by his family under the care of Alive Hospice. With a courageous heart and a deep, unwavering faith, he waged a valiant, prolonged fight against numerous diseases, procedures, and surgeries, finally losing his battle with cancer. Throughout his ordeals and hospitalizations, his wife, Cathy, stayed by his side strongly advocating for his care.

Funeral Services will be at 10 a.m., Friday, May 27, 2022, at White House First United Methodist Church with the Rev. Travis Garner officiating.
