Charlie "Preston" Winters, age 96 of the Brewer's Chapel Community in Cheatham County, Tennessee, died Thursday, August 6, 2020 at the Waters of Cheatham in Ashland City.

A graveside service will be held in Resthaven Memorial Gardens in Clarksville at 10 o' clock am on Monday, August 10th, with Pastor Penny Stratton officiating. Burial will follow with Tommy Castleberry, Jeff Castleberry, Dillon Castleberry, Preston Castleberry, Destin Maurer, and Rich Steele serving as pallbearers.
