Robin Paul Bowie, age 76, of Greenbrier, passed away Wednesday, May 18, 2016 at Maury Regional Medical Center after a courageous battle with cancer. A graveside service will be held Saturday, May 21, 2016 at 9:30am in the Mt. Sharon Cemetery with Brother Ron Bowie officiating. Burial will follow with family and friends serving as pallbearers. A private visitation will be held at the Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Springfield on Saturday morning.

Mr. Bowie was born December 13, 1939 in Robertson County to the late Robin Earl and Thelma Head Bowie.
