



## Roy Elmer Bristol,

May 22, 1927 - July 20, 2014

Roy Elmer Bristol, Jr., age 87, of Springfield, passed away Sunday, July 20, 2014 at his home. A memorial service will be held in the chapel of the Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Springfield on Friday, July 25, 2014 at 7pm. Visitation with the family will be held at the funeral home on Friday evening from 6pm until the hour of service.
