



Sandra Brown Goad

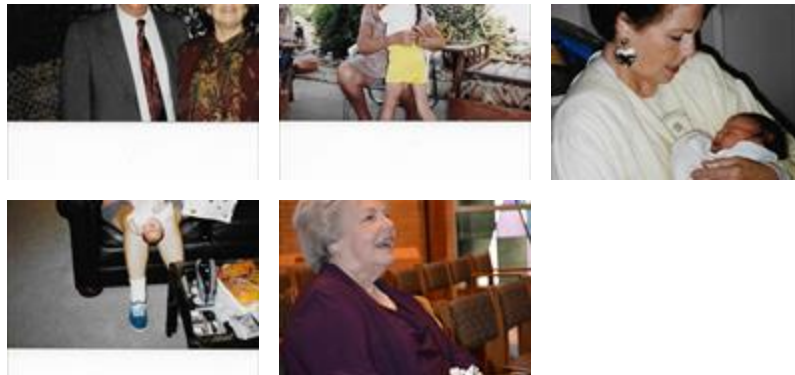
June 6, 1935 - April 24, 2014
