Shirley Fay Rountree Dunn, age 93, of Springfield, passed away Friday, April 10 at Northcrest Medical Center. 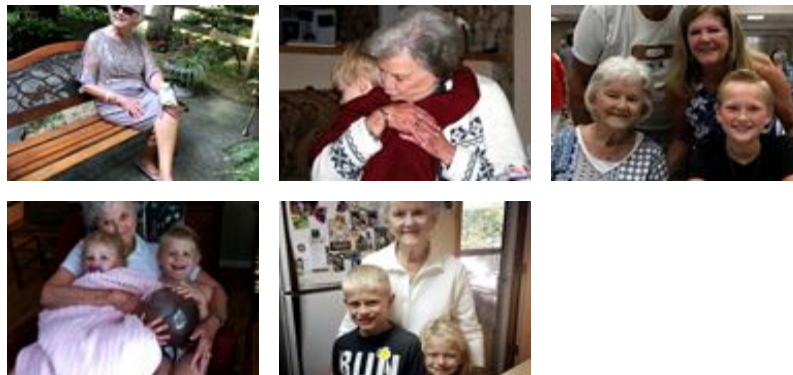
