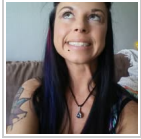

Every time we had a sleepover during my childhood, we would have a tea party. Fancy tea set, pinkies up, all of it! She made me feel so cool.

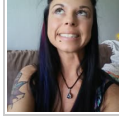
