



## Theadore "Ted" E. Daily

June 8, 1925 - July 17, 2013

Theadore Edwin Daily, age 88, of Springfield, passed away Wednesday, July 17, 2013 at Morningside of Springfield. Funeral services will be held Sunday, July 21, 2013 at 2pm in the chapel of the Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Springfield with Dr. Tommy Crunk and Brother Eric Taylor officiating. He was inducted as a Shriner in 1966. He and his devoted wife, Frances, were married 49 years and were always a fun-loving couple, enjoying family and friends. He was a born-again Christian and member of the First United Methodist Church in Springfield.

granddaughter, Michelle Daily and three sisters, Alice Julia and Ilene.
