



Thomas Carroll

May 10, 1920 - August 18, 2016

Thomas Monroe Carroll, age 96, of Springfield, entered into everlasting life on Thursday, August 18, 2016, at his home. Funeral services will be held Saturday, August 20, 2016 at 3pm in the chapel of the Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Springfield with Brother Daniel Dennis officiating. Burial will follow in the Oakland Cemetery with Jackie Webster, Charles Webster, Johnson Privett, Max Waldrop, Kyle Tate and Chad Tate serving as pallbearers. Brother Jake Townsend will officiate the interment. Visitation will be held at the funeral home on Saturday from 12 Noon until the hour of service at 3pm.

Mr. Carroll was born May 10, 1920 in Robertson County to the late Tom York and Floyd Roe Carroll. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army, and was a member of Oakland Baptist Church having given his life to Jesus in the fall of 1940. He was a furniture maker for Davis Cabinet Company until 1990 and painted with his best friend, James Bradford, until retiring in 1998.

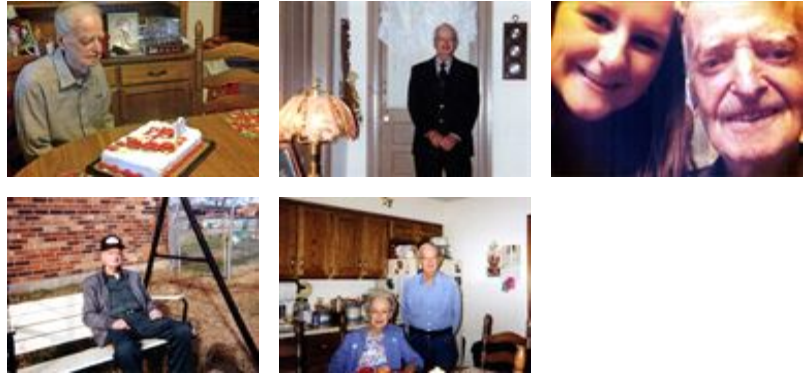
