Timothy "Tim" Jayson Helm, age 54 of Joelton, Tennessee died Tuesday, June 16, 2020 at his home.

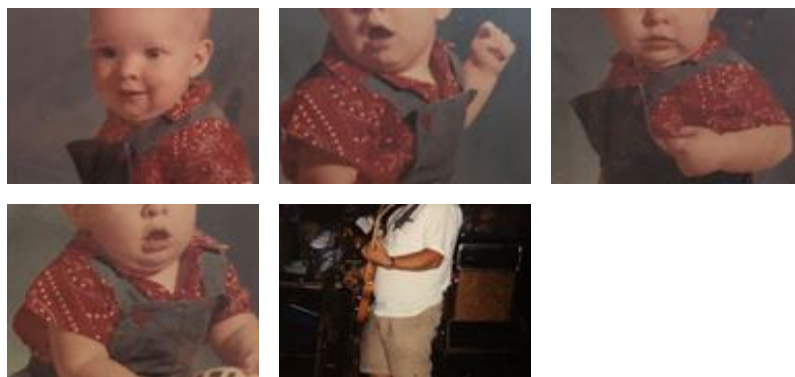
