Victor Kenneth Jenkins, age 76, of Cedar Hill, passed away Wednesday, July 7, 2010 at his home. Funeral services will be held Monday, July 12, 2010 at 10am in the chapel of the Austin & Bell Funeral Home in Springfield with Father George Chennapallil officiating.
