He was previously employed by John Rochford in Nashville, TN. He was credited with building the smallest tugboat on the Ohio River. It was the most powerful one built for it's size and was named for him. He accepted Jesus as his Savior in January and was baptized on July 18th at Orlinda Baptist Church, where he had been attending. He is preceded in death by his parents; 2 children, Coby Remo and an unborn infant.
