Bill grew up in Montgomery County and joined the Navy at age 17. He married

contractor in the Birdcage for the Armed Forces Special Weapons Project. His
career
path moved the family to TX where he worked for the government at Pantex
which is
responsible for maintaining the nation's nuclear arsenal. He moved the family
back
home to TN in 1974 to run the family farms that he and Mary grew up on in
Cheatham
and Montgomery County for 14 years. Afterwards, Bill worked for the East
Montgomery
Utility District for several years before retiring.

Bill was a dedicated husband, father, grandfather, and mentor to many people
who was
beloved by family and friends. He was an active member of Mallory's Church
dating
back to 1960 who served as the Treasurer of both the church and cemetery
for over 40
years. He was very outgoing, always on the move, full of life and it's safe to
say that he

never met a stranger. He had a heart of gold and would gladly give the shirt off his back to those in need. Bill will be greatly missed by his family and friends, but his memory will remain in the hearts of all those who knew him.

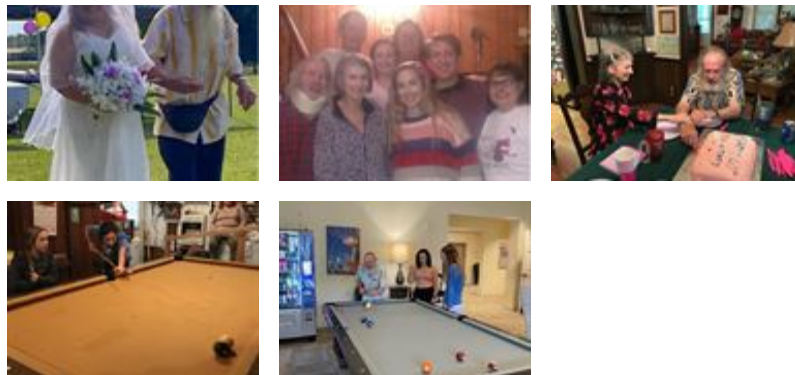
